Andrena columbiana Viereck, 1917 is listed in the University of Alaska Museum Insect Collection (UAM) checklist. No voucher specimens exist for this record. Presence is based on two literature citations Krombein et al. (1979) and Ascher (2008). Krombein et al. (1979) do not list the species as occurring in Alaska, but list it from British Columbia to Mexico. Ascher (2008) cites two observations, one from Fairbanks (origin Univ. New Mexico; ID_parent LLL31) and one from the UAM checklist. The Symbiota Collections of Arthropods Network (SCAN) holds Univ. New Mexico data and did not produce results of this taxon for Alaska, but had records far north as southern British Columbia.

Until a voucher is produced, this taxon does not occur in Alaska.
